Η λίστα Sunday Times Rich περιλαμβάνει τους 1,000 πιο πλούσιους ανθρώπους του Ηνωμένου Βασιλείου και ανανεώνεται κάθε Απρίλιο, ενώ δημοσιεύεται από τη βρετανική εφημερίδα The Sunday Times από το 1989.

Από αυτήν δεν λείπουν οι Κύπριοι, κάποιοι από τους οποίους φιγουράρουν σε πολύ υψηλές θέσεις στην κατάταξη.


Ο πιο πλούσιος Κύπριος στη λίστα είναι ο Ιδρυτής της εταιρείας Easy Jet, Sir Stelios Haji-Loannou, που βρίσκεται στη θέση 48 και η περιουσία του φτάνει στις 2,95 δισ. αγγλικές λίρες.

Ο δεύτερος Κύπριος στη συγκεκριμένη λίστα είναι ο Alki David και κατατάσσεται στη θέση 62 με περιουσία £2.2 δισ. Γεννήθηκε στη Νιγηρία από Κύπριους γονείς ενώ ζει στη Βρετανία και στο Λος Άντζελες.

Ο Alki David κατέχει την εταιρεία FilmOn, μια επιχείρηση ζωντανής ροής στο



διαδίκτυο, η οποία επιτρέπει την πρόσβαση σε ζωντανή μετάδοση HDTV μέσω H/Y, τηλεοράσεων και κινητών τηλεφώνων αξίας άνω των 500 εκατομμυρίων λιρών. Κατέχει πάνω από το 80% του μεριδίου.

Ο Alki David είναι μέλος της οικογένειας Leventis, η οποία συγχώνευσε την εταιρεία εμφιάλωσης της με την Coca Cola για να δημιουργήσει τη διεθνή εταιρεία εμφιάλωσης ποτών Coca Cola HBC στο Λονδίνο. Η αξία της επιχείρησης



φτάνει στα 8,2 δισεκατομμύρια λίρες.

Τρίτη πιο πλούσια είναι η οικογένεια Lazari στην 66η θέση με περιουσία £22 δισ.

Ο θάνατος του Chris Lazaris πριν από δύο χρόνια άφησε ένα μεγάλο κενό στον χώρο της αγοράς ακινήτων. Ο Chris καταγόταν από την Κύπρο, ξεκίνησε από τον χώρο της μόδας ενώ στη συνέχεια ίδρυσε την Lazari Investments, που ακμάζει στο κεντρικό και βόρειο Λονδίνο και τώρα

διακείται από τα τρία παιδία του. Ο τέταρτος πιο πλούσιος Κύπριος είναι ο 52χρονος John Christodoulou με περιουσία £1.5 δισ. και βρίσκεται στην 90η θέση στην κατάταξη.

Γεννήθηκε στη Λευκωσία αλλά μετανάστευσε στη Βρετανία μετά την τουρκική εισβολή.

Ο John Christodoulou είναι ιδιοκτήτης των πεντάστερων ξενοδοχείων Marriott και Four Seasons, κατέχει 2.000 οικιστικές και εμπορικές μονάδες στο κεντρικό Λονδίνο, γη στη Βραζιλίας, διαμερίσματα στη Νέα Υόρκη, το Hilton Tower του Μάντσεστερ και το Radisson Blu του Λίβερπουλ.

Ο πέμπτος είναι ο Theo Paphitis, γεννήθηκε στη Λεμεσό το 1959 και μετανάστευσε στη Βρετανία σε ηλικία έξι ετών. Πήγε σχολείο στο βόρειο Λονδίνο αλλά έκει δεν κατάφεραν να ανιχνεύσουν τη δυσλεξία και η πρώτη του δουλειά στα 16 του ήταν να βοηθάει στην παρασκευή τσαγιού στην Lloyd's.

Το 2015 ο Theo δημιούργησε τον όμιλο Theo Paphitis Retail Group ο οποίος αποτελείται από τις εταιρείες Ryman Stationery, Robert Dyas και Boux Avenue.

Ο Όμιλος έχει υπό την ιδιοκτησία του 350 καταστήματα και εξυπηρετεί περισσότερους από 28 εκατομμύρια καταναλωτές ετησίως. Η περιουσία του φτάνει στις £301 εκατομμύρια και βρίσκεται στην 409η θέση.

Δραματική αύξηση της εγκληματικότητας και οι περικοπές στην αστυνόμευση

Ζούμε σε μια κοινωνία, όπου κάθε μέρα αντιμετωπίζουμε καινούργια προβλήματα που δημιουργούνται από τους ίδιους τους ανθρώπους. Κι' ένα από τα χειρότερα προβλήματα, είναι το έγκλημα, το οποίο συνεχώς αυξάνεται.

Το κείμενό μας, βασίζεται στα τεκταινόμενα στη Βρετανία και αφορά στην αύξηση του οργανωμένου εγκλήματος. Σίγουρα, το πρόβλημα είναι «κοινό» σε πολλές χώρες, αν όχι σε όλες. Ανάμεσά τους και η Κύπρος μας, που τον τελευταίο καιρό δεν αποτελεί εξαίρεση. Η εγκληματικότητα έχει προσλάβει σοβαρές διαστάσεις, αλλά και πιο βίαιες μορφές. Τα ποσοστά της εγκληματικότητας αυξάνονται ολοένα και πιο πολύ, σε βαθμό που μπορούν να θεωρηθούν, χωρίς υπερβολή, ανεξέλεκτα.

Στη Βρετανία, από στοιχεία που δόθηκαν στη δημοσιότητα από το Υπουργείο Εσωτερικών (Home Office), προκύπτει ότι τα εγκλήματα είναι τόσα πολλά, που κατά τον περασμένο χρόνο έφτασαν τα δύο εκατομμύρια. Μισό εκατομμύριο απ' αυτά, παραμένουν ανεξιχνίαστα και αφορούν μεταξύ άλλων ανθρωποκτονίες, ληστείες, κλοπές, σκόπιμους εμπρησμούς και γενικά, όλων των ειδών κακουργήματα.

Πρόσφατα, έρευνα επί του θέματος που διενεργήθηκε από το Εργατικό Κόμμα, καταδεικνύει πως ένα εκατομμύριο εγκλήματα παραμένουν

ανεξιχνίαστα πέραν των τριών χρόνων. Ο αριθμός των ανεξιχνίαστων εγκλημάτων μεταξύ των ετών 2014-17, καταδεικνύει επίσης ότι η κυβέρνηση των Συντηρητικών παρέχει στους πολίτες «φθηνή ασφάλεια», δήλωσε ο εκπρόσωπος του Εργατικού Κόμματος υπεύθυνος για την αστυνόμευση. Τα συμπεράσματα της έρευνας είναι καταπέλτης, αφού αποκαλύπτουν τα τραγικά αποτελέσματα που είχαν οι περικοπές που έγιναν στη χρηματοδότηση της Αστυνομίας.

Προκύπτει εξάλλου, ότι είναι πολύ εύκολο για τον οποιονδήποτε να αγοράσει όπλο και μαχαίρι. Ακόμη και για νεαρά παιδιά, γεγονός που συμβάλει δυστυχώς στην αύξηση των σοβαρών εγκλημάτων. Από τις αρχές του τρέχοντος χρόνου, περισσότεροι από 50 άνθρωποι έχουν σκοτωθεί ή μαχαιρωθεί στο Λονδίνο, κάνοντας για πρώτη φορά στη σύγχρονη ιστορία, το ποσοστό δολοφονίας στην πρωτεύουσα, υψηλότερο από αυτό της Νέας Υόρκης.

Η «Παροικιακή» ασχολήθηκε με τις περικοπές στην Αστυνομία, όταν η κυβέρνηση των Τόριδων πρωτο-ξεκίνησε αυτή την επικίνδυνη πολιτική. Το 2015, η εφημερίδα μας έγραφε σε σχετικό άρθρο: «...περικοπές ήδη έγιναν, αλλά

αναμένονται και άλλες στην Αστυνομία, σε μια κρίσιμη περίοδο, αφού μετά τα πρόσφατα γεγονότα, χρειάζονται περισσότερες θέσεις. Κι' αν είναι δυνατό να αυξηθούν στο διπλάσιο. Οι περικοπές αφορούν την αστυνόμευση, ένα τομέα

Το ερώτημα που είχε θέσει η εφημερίδα μας πριν από τρία χρόνια, ισχύει και σήμερα. Η απάντηση, προκύπτει πλέον από τα αποτελέσματα. Είναι αποδειγμένο λοιπόν εκ του αποτελέσματος, ότι πάμε προς το χειρότερο.



χνίασης πολλών εγκλημάτων, στις πολλαπλές περικοπές που έγιναν στο αστυνομικό σώμα. Παράλληλα, αναδεικνύει ως αδυναμία της Αστυνομίας την αύξηση του σοβαρού, βίαιου εγκλήματος, υπογραμμίζοντας το γεγονός ότι λειτουργεί με περίπου 21 χιλιάδες λιγότερους αστυνομικούς, σε σύγκριση με το 2010.

Ακόμη, σύμφωνα με την τελευταία έκθεση του Ανεξάρτητου Παραποτητρίου Αστυνόμευσης, προκύπτει ένα εθνικό έλλειμμα περισσότερων από 5 χιλιάδες εξεταστών και ντετέκτιβ. Αυτή η έλλειψη αντιπροσωπεύει «εθνική κρίση», σύμφωνα με την έκθεση της Επιθεώρησης της Ανώτατης Επιχείρησης Αστυνομίας και Πυροσβεστικών Υπηρεσιών.

Εύστοχη η δήλωση της σκιώδους Υπουργού Εσωτερικών, κυρίας Λουίζας Χένκ που είπε: «Δεν μπορεί να γίνεται φθηνή η ασφάλεια του λαού. Αναμφίβολα, η Συντηρητική κυβέρνηση απέτυχε να επενδύσει σωστά στην αστυνόμευση. Συνεπώς, δεν μπορεί να ριψοκινδυνεύει την ασφάλεια της κοινωνίας και να αφήνει το λαό στο έλεος του εγκλήματος».

«Ευρεία και βαθιά» συνεργασία άμυνας και ασφάλειας θέλει η Βρετανία μετά το Brexit

Το βρετανικό Υπουργείο Brexit δημοσίευσε την πρότασή του για τη μελλοντική συνεργασία του Ηνωμένου Βασιλείου με την ΕΕ στον τομέα της ασφάλειας και της άμυνας. Το έγγραφο αναφέρεται σε ένα όραμα μίας συνεργασίας «ανεπανάληπτης σε εύρος και βάθος».

Προτείνει τη δημιουργία ενός πλαισίου το οποίο «θα πρωθεί την κοινή ασφάλεια και θα αναπτύσσει τη συνερ-

γασία», η οποία παράλληλα «πρέπει να σέβεται τόσο την αυτονομία της λήψης αποφάσεων της ΕΕ όσο και την κυριαρχία του Ηνωμένου Βασιλείου».

Η συνεργασία θα βασίζεται σε τρεις πυλώνες, κατά τη βρετανική πρόταση: την εσωτερική ασφάλεια, την εξωτερική ασφάλεια και την ευρύτερη συνεργασία.

Το έγγραφο καταλήγει προτείνοντας την υιοθέτηση και

σία. Διπλωμάτες επισημαίνουν ότι όπως όλοι οι εταίροι έτσι και η Ελλάδα με την Κύπρο θέλουν μία στενή σχέση ασφάλειας και άμυνας με τη Βρετανία.

Υπάγονται, ωστόσο, σε μία ομάδα χωρών-μελών οι οποίες δε θέλουν σε καμία περίπτωση να αποκτήσει η Βρετανία δικαιώματα καθορισμού πολιτικών άμυνας και ασφάλειας της ΕΕ που θα μπορούσαν να λειτουργήσουν ως προηγούμενο για άλλες τρίτες χώρες, που έχουν ήδη κάποια σχέση με την ΕΕ, όπως η Τουρκία.

Το Υπουργικό Συμβούλιο αποφάσισε πρόσφατα, ως κατάληξη προηγούμενων συζητήσεων στη Βουλή των Αντιπροσώπων, όπου έγινε πάρα πολλές φορές συζήτηση με πρωτοβουλία του προέδρου της Επιτροπής Εργασίας, Ανδρέα Φακοντή, να εγκρίνει σχέδιο επιδόματος για όσους έκαναν θητεία μεγαλύτερη της προκαθορισμένης στην περίοδο της τουρκικής εισβολής του 1974, καθώς και για αιχμαλώτους και παθόντες πολέμου.

Την απόφαση του υπουργικού ανακοίνωσε η Αναπληρώτρια Κυβερνητική Εκπρόσωπος Κλέλια Βασιλείου.

Σύμφωνα με την κ. Βασιλείου, «πρόκειται για 472 περίπου πρόσωπα και το σχέδιο θα καλυφθεί με πρόσθιτη επήσια δαπάνη 300 χιλιάδων ευρώ από το Υπουργείο Εργασίας».

AKEL and Sol Hareket leaders warn about negative consequences of a two state solution



General Secretary of the opposition left wing party AKEL Andros Kyrianiou and leader of the Turkish Cypriot Movement Sol Hareket warned about the negative consequences to the country and the people of Cyprus of a possible solution to the Cyprus issue based on a confederation or a two-state basis.

The two leaders met on Monday at the AKEL offices in Nicosia.

Speaking after the meeting, Kyrianiou said that they worry about the approach of Turkey for a two-state solution and the approaches that come about in the two communities of the island that are in favour of such a solution.

"AKEL considers that such development would be

catastrophic for the people of Cyprus as a whole and we are not going to accept it," he said.

Leader of Sol Hareket, Abdullah Korkmazhan, said that after the failure of the Cyprus talks in the Swiss resort in Crans Montana last summer, we are faced with a prolonged stalemate.

He said that the Movement

demands the resumption of the negotiations from the point they were left the soonest possible and based on the UNSG's Framework.

He added that the Turkish Cypriot leader Mustafa Akinci has already made the first step by expressing his readiness to accept that Framework as a strategic agreement between the two sides.

Presidential Commissioner urges Turkey to cooperate on missing persons in Cyprus

President Photis Photiou has conveyed the message that after 44 years the relatives of missing persons from the Turkish invasion of Cyprus in 1974 should no longer have to live in pain, stressing that Turkey should cooperate, grant access to records, military zones and to information for the intentional transfer of remains from their original burial sites.

Photiou, who was briefing students at the regional high school of Pera Chorio Nisou village on humanitarian issues and the efforts to resolve them during a visit they paid the Presidential Palace, also referred to matters related with the enclaved in the Turkish occupied areas of the island and stressed that Turkey's



provocations within Cyprus' Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) "cannot be accepted," a presidency press release said.

The Presidential Commissioner said that both the findings in mass graves and witness accounts and evidence which is found for every missing person's case are truly shocking to all."

The work of the Committee

on Missing Persons (CMP) cannot be overlooked, he noted, adding however that "851 of our compatriots are still missing," which account for the majority of those included in the missing persons list.

Hundreds of Greek Cypriots went missing during the 1974 Turkish invasion of Cyprus, most of them combatants but also women,

children and elderly people. During the same period and in the early 1960 when inter-communal fighting broke out Turkish Cypriots went missing too.

A Committee on Missing Persons has been established, upon agreement between the leaders of the two communities, with the scope of exhuming, identifying and returning the remains of missing persons to their relatives.

The CMP is a tripartite inter-communal investigatory committee comprising a representative of the Greek Cypriot community, a representative of the Turkish Cypriot community, and a Third Member nominated by the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) and appointed by the UN Secretary General.

Cyprus concerned with serious escalation of situation in Gaza

The Republic of Cyprus maintains the position that the final status of Jerusalem is to be determined through negotiations, noting that it is concerned over the serious escalation of the situation in Gaza and that further loss of life must be avoided.

"The Republic of Cyprus is concerned with today's serious escalation of the situation in Gaza resulting in dozens of Palestinians killed and hundreds injured. Further loss of life must be avoided and we call on all to demonstrate utmost restraint," the Ministry of Foreign Affairs says in a press statement.

It notes that "what the

entire world is witnessing puts into even sharper focus the imperative need for the two sides to resume negotiations for a peaceful resolution to the Palestinian-Israeli conflict in the framework of the two-state solution, which will be to the benefit of Palestinians and Israelis and will contribute significantly towards peace and security for the whole region."

"Cyprus maintains the position that the final status of Jerusalem, the holy city for the three monotheistic faiths; Christianity, Islam and Judaism, is to be determined through negotiations," the press statement concludes.

EasyJet founder Stelios Hadjioannou is estimated to be the richest Cypriot in Britain, according to this year's 'Rich List' published by the Sunday Times.

The list includes the 1,000 richest people or families in the UK.

Sir Stelios is ranked number 48 with a fortune of £2.95 billion.

Second among Cypriots is Alkis David and the Leventis family, in 62nd place with assets totalling £2.2 billion. David's assets include the live-streaming service FilmOn, while the Leventis family, of which David is part, is estimated to hold a £1.9 billion share in Coca-Cola HBC.

At number 66 is the Lazari family with its large real estate holdings.

Ranked the 90th wealthy person in the UK is Cypriot John Christodoulou, again because of real estate assets, which are worth £1.5 billion.

Theo Pafitis, whose businesses focus on women's lingerie and stationery, is valued at £301 million, which places him at number 409.



One other Cypriot on the list is Stelios Stefanou, founder of the charity Stefanou Foundation. With a fortune estimated at £140 million, he is ranked 793 on the rich list.

The 19th wealthiest person in the UK also has a connection to Cyprus. Norwegian shipping mogul John Fredricksen has got Cypriot citizenship and his fortune is valued at £6.7 billion.

The richest man in Britain for 2018 is self-made billionaire Jim Ratcliffe from a suburb of Manchester.

The property of the 65-year-old Brit is worth £21.05 billion.

UK Cypriots urge PM May to defend reunification efforts in meeting with Erdogan

The UK Prime Minister Theresa May was urged to stress her Government's support in the efforts to reunify Cyprus in a meeting with Turkey's President Recep Tayyip Erdogan which took place on Tuesday at Downing Street.

In a letter addressed to the Prime Minister, the President of the National Federation of Cypriots in the UK Christos Karaolis described the meeting as an opportunity for Mrs May "to make a lasting difference for Cyprus" and "to make a positive contribution towards efforts to reunify Cyprus for the benefit of all its people."

In his letter Karaolis urged the UK leader to ask President Erdogan if he is committed to the resolution of the Cyprus issue based on a bi-zonal, bi-communal federation with political equality as described by the relevant United Nations Security Council Resolutions.

"A number of comments from officials in the Turkish Government since the unsuccessful outcome of the negotiations in Crans Montana last July, and even as recently as last week, have indicated a worrying shift towards a 'plan b', outside of UN parameters.



Comments such as that undermine the efforts of President Anastasiades and Turkish Cypriot leader Mustafa Akinci to reunify the island. Such comments are also contrary to the long-standing position of the UK Government and, therefore, should be condemned. Your meeting with President Erdogan provides an excellent opportunity to communicate the unequivocal position of the UK Government in favour of a solution based on the relevant UN Security Council Resolutions and High-Level Agreements, and to make clear that the UK does not support ideas for a solution outside of the UN

parameters or implementing any 'plan b', he notes. Secondly, he asked the Prime Minister to communicate to President Erdogan that a solution which will see the continuation of the Treaty of Guarantees and the presence of Turkish troops on the island is neither just nor viable. "The UN Secretary General has been clear that there is a need for a new security system in Cyprus, and not a continuation of the old one. This means that the anachronistic system of guarantors and intervention rights must end, a position which I understand is shared by the UK Government. There must

also be a rapid reduction from the first day of a solution and then a clear end-date for the presence of Turkish troops in Cyprus. A reunified Cyprus should be a modern, sovereign, and 'normal' member of the United Nations, and does not need guarantors with the right to unilateral military intervention, nor foreign troops on the island," states Karaolis. Finally, he noted that UK Cypriots were appalled as Turkey deployed warships to block legally-permitted exploratory drilling in the Republic of Cyprus' Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ).

"We were satisfied to see our government support the Republic of Cyprus' right to explore and exploit its natural resources, for the benefit of all Cypriots, in its EEZ but I would like you to urge President Erdogan to respect Cyprus' sovereignty and rights in its EEZ and avoid actions or threats that escalate tensions in the Eastern Mediterranean. Gunboat diplomacy should have no place in the 21st Century, particularly towards an island with such close economic, cultural and historical ties to the UK," concluded the UK Cypriots' Federation President.

AKEL and T/C Communal Democracy Party agree on need for Cyprus talks to resume

Left-wing opposition party AKEL and Turkish Cypriot Communal Democracy Party have agreed on the need for the Cyprus talks to resume and for a solution to be achieved as soon as possible.

Delegations of the two parties met on Friday at AKEL's offices in Nicosia where they also decided to establish a joint committee that would work towards the goal to resume the Cyprus talks after the elections in Turkey (end of June).

They also expressed their support towards a federal solution while voicing their opposition towards any other sort of solution, including the one of two states. The two parties agreed that the Cyprus



talks must resume from the point they were left last July during the talks at the Swiss resort of Crans Montana.

The leaders of the two parties, AKEL General

Secretary Andros Kyprianou and Chairman of the Turkish Cypriot party Cemal Özyigit placed emphasis on the escalating crisis in the Middle East region and underlined the

need for the Cyprus problem to be solved.

In his statements, Kyprianou said that AKEL will never accept a two states solution, underlining that the only way forward is a bizonal, bicomunal federation, with one sovereignty, one international personality and one citizenship and political equality, as outlined in the UN resolutions.

He also referred to the hydrocarbon reserves found in Cyprus' Exclusive Economic Zone, saying that they belong to Greek Cypriots and Turkish Cypriots and added that the right solution of the Cyprus problem will enable the two communities to exploit those reserves and enjoy any benefits that come along.

In his statements, Özyigit said that his party supports a solution based on the existing parameters, which are the UN resolutions, the High Level Agreements, the Christofias - Talat convergences, the joint communiqué of the 11th of February 2014, and the UNSG's framework, noting that his party is against any solution which falls outside those parameters, like a two states solution.

He pointed out that his party is determined to continue the cooperation with AKEL and intensify it after the elections in Turkey on 24th June.

Open letter to British PM regarding Erdogan visit

The following open letter was sent by Lobby for Cyprus to Prime Minister Theresa May regarding President Erdogan's visit to the UK:

Dear Prime Minister

President Erdogan's visit to the UK will take place against the shadows cast by his destruction of democracy in Turkey, his government's appalling human rights record, his country's gunboat diplomacy and the enduring consequences of the two Turkish invasions of the Republic of Cyprus in 1974.

Having ethno-religiously cleansed and colonised 36 per cent of the territory (and 57 per cent of the coastline) of the Republic of Cyprus, Turkey continues to occupy its northern areas in flagrant breach of international law and in a throwback to the Ottoman imperial epoch when Turkey misruled the Island of Cyprus from 1571 until 1878.

If and when you, any other Minister of the Crown or HM The Queen meet President Erdogan during his forthcoming visit, we trust and expect that certain messages will be delivered to him by Her Majesty's Government:

- Turkey **must** comply with international humanitarian law, international human rights law, international law generally, the norms of democracy and the humane values of the UN, NATO and the Council of Europe of which Turkey is a Member State;

- Turkey **must** withdraw all of its armed forces and all of its other state agents from the Turkish-occupied north of the Republic of Cyprus;

- Turkey **must** humanely repatriate all of its citizens who have been illegally colonising or otherwise illegally living in the Turkish-occupied north of the Republic of Cyprus in breach of the law of the Republic of Cyprus and also in breach of Article 49(6) of the Fourth Geneva Convention 1949;

- Turkey **must** be held to account for the international crimes and human rights violations for which it is responsible, including the forced eviction and forcible transfer of more than 170,000 people from their homes in the Turkish-occupied north of the Republic of Cyprus, the arbitrary steps taken to prevent these people from recovering possession of their homes or other properties and the purported appropriation of these properties by the illegal subordinate administration of Turkey;

- Turkey **must** stop threatening the Republic of Cyprus and it **must** also refrain from engaging in any action which interferes with the legal rights of the Republic of Cyprus, including the right to exploit its own hydrocarbon resources;

- Turkey **must not** use any British-made arms, weapons or other military exports to support its illegal

occupation of the north of the Republic of Cyprus or for any other purposes which are unlawful or unethical.

If and when you or HM The Queen meet President Erdogan, we trust and expect that he will also be warned that the national security, national interests and democratic values of the UK will not be satisfied unless and until any 'settlement' is achieved via a transparent and democratic procedure which *inter alia*:

- complies with democratic norms, the principles of justice and the rule of law;

- protects the fundamental rights of all citizens and lawful residents of the Republic of Cyprus;

- ends the apartheid-style differentiation of citizens along 'bi-communal' ethno-religious lines and their enforced 'bi-zonal' segregation into separate and segregated 'zones' built along the same lines;

- ends Turkey's illegal occupation via the withdrawal of all Turkish armed forces, agents and colonists;

- guarantees that all displaced persons will recover possession of the homes and properties from which they were forcibly evicted;

- accounts for the whereabouts of all prisoners of war and all other persons who went missing;

- terminates the anachronistic concept of 'guarantor powers' and, in line with European norms, anoints independent judges as the guarantors of legality, justice and human rights;

- ensures that Turkey signs and becomes a state party to a host of international treaties of fundamental importance to peace, justice or security such as the 1973 Crime of Apartheid Convention, the 1977 Additional Protocols to the Geneva Conventions, the 1982 UN Convention on the Law of the Sea, the 1998 Rome Statute on the International Criminal Court and the 2006 International Convention for the Protection of All Persons from Enforced Disappearance.

In short, President Erdogan must be told in no uncertain terms that the United Kingdom will not countenance any settlement which fails to provide for a truly free, democratic, united, unitary, independent, sovereign and secure Republic of Cyprus which is not scarred by any occupation, segregation, partition or any other form of division. President Erdogan must also be warned that if Turkey does not abide by the above conditions forthwith, the United Kingdom will call for international sanctions and other restrictive measures to be imposed on Turkey.

I look forward to hearing from you with confirmation that each of the above messages will be or has been transmitted to President Erdogan.

Katerina Gavrielidou: Royal invitation by the King of the Belgians

Katerina Gavrielidou was invited by the King of Belgians as a Next Generation Leader to give her ideas and solutions to global problems of the 21st century.

The meeting was held within the framework of the 2018 Laeken Dialogue, which took place at the Royal Palace of Brussels and Egmont Palace between 2-3 May.

King Philippe of Belgium invited a total of thirteen Next Generation Leaders from Europe, Asia and America for a roundtable discussion on the challenges of the 21st century from their standpoint as disruptors, innovators, and entrepreneurs. Katerina Gavrielidou and the rest of the young leaders had a very fruitful discussion with King Philippe, highlighting issues that they themselves consider to be of the utmost importance and proposing solutions to them.

At the opening dinner of the 2018 Laeken Dialogue the King and the Queen of the Belgians warmly welcomed the guests at the Royal Palace of Brussels, and discussed with the young leaders in a friendly manner. The Belgian Foreign Minister



Reynders Didier also hosted a working lunch at Egmont Palace during the second day of the dialogue.

Laeken Dialogue is organized each year by the King of the Belgians and Asia Society in order to identify strategic solutions to global problems by existing and emerging leaders. This year's event was attended by a total of 60 leaders from around the world, such as the Belgian Foreign Minister Reynders Didier, the High Representative of the European Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy Federica Mogherini, the 26th Prime Minister of Australia Kevin Rudd, the Minister of State of Belgium Frans Van Daele, the First President of European Council and Prime Minister of the Kingdom of

Belgium Herman Van Rompuy, as well as the Next Generation Leaders.

It is worth noting that this was the second year that King Philippe invited young people to participate in the dialogue, during which they had the opportunity to exchange views with the leaders in presence, and to gain experience and knowledge from a supreme diplomatic event such as the Laeken Dialogue.

Katerina Gavrielidou is a Political Scientist with a Master's degree in European Politics from the London School of Economics, and President & Founder of The European Cyprus Society. She interned at the European Parliament in Brussels and the House of Representatives of the Republic of Cyprus.

She then studied Politics, Philosophy, and History courses at Oxford University, and Leadership at Cambridge University.

Katerina represented Cyprus in multiple youth programs and conferences in Europe and worldwide, and contributed to global declarations on Youth. Between 2015-2017 she represented European youth at the UN Habitat Youth Advisory Board, where young people from all over the world elected her. In June 2016, Katerina was awarded the Queen's Young Leaders Award as one of the 60 most commendable young leaders of the Commonwealth. She is an Honorary Member of the Hellenic Association of Political Scientists, and participated in Model Greek Parliament in Athens, initially as a Member of Parliament and then as President of a Parliamentary Group of the simulation.

Katerina Gavrielidou was recently listed on Forbes 30 Under 30 list as one of the 30 most influential young leaders of Europe. Among her other distinctions are the Greek International Women Award in Social Science, and her nomination as UN Youth Envoy.

Education conference on the Greek language held in Birmingham



On Sunday 29th April 2018, I was very fortunate to attend the all-day educational conference titled: "Greek Language: A Learning Journey at a Greek Community School." The conference was organized by the Cyprus Educational Mission to the UK in cooperation with the Greek schools and the communities of Agia Triada and Apostolos Andreas in Birmingham, and it was under the auspices of the Ministry of Education and Culture of the Republic of Cyprus. The conference was very well-attended by many teachers and parents from various parts of the country.

The conference started with warm welcome remarks from the Committee Chairs of both community schools, as well as with greetings from the Head of the Cyprus Education Mission to the UK Mrs. Papalouca, and the Education Coordinator of the Greek Embassy in London, Mr. Kosyvas. Mrs. Papalouca emphasized the importance of good planning and substantive work that needs to take place in Greek schools early on. Mr. Kosyvas emphasized the importance of setting up high expectations for all students and the need for high quality training of all people involved with the work of Greek schools (Committees, Heads and all other staff).

The conference programme was quite comprehensive, as

it has covered various topics having to do with the work taking place at the Greek community schools. The first set of presentations was about how to effectively work with the younger students. Mrs M Karagiorgi emphasized the importance of developing oral skills and vocabulary among young students and adapting the material based on their particular needs and readiness.

Mrs A Tantarouda and M Koufomeriti talked about ways to enhance communication between schools and families and presented the "Learning Journey Books and Portfolios" which record the work and progress of students throughout the year. Dr. Sextou talked about the importance of incorporating theatre and drama among younger students upon learning the Greek language. Mrs Spyridonos presented and analysed the four basic competencies Greek schools work for and emphasized the importance of continuous assessment of all

students.

The second set of presentations was about ways to manage people in Greek communities and strengthen their ties. Prof. A Psychogios talked about the challenges that complex communities face and how leadership needs to be more "relational." Dr A Antiliou talked about the particularities of Greek community schools and presented ways that we can recruit and retain students. Dr. Stella Tryfonos talked about the role of technology upon strengthening ties among all people involved in Greek community schools and shared examples from *Class dojo*, an electronic platform for managing and assessing the work that takes place in schools, as well as communicating with families. Mrs A Vai Nicolaou talked about everyone's responsibility to safeguard children under our care and the importance of setting up child protection policies.

The last set of presentations aimed at informing the parti-

cipants about the upcoming changes in the GCSE (effective in 2019) and A Level exams (effective in 2020). Mrs Panagiota Magou-Sergi, Marina Charalambidi, and Panagiota Vasilaki talked about the GCSE exam and Dr. Marios Psaras about the A Level exam.

The conference ended with a wonderful workshop organized by Mrs. Vasiliki Kyriacou, Eugenia Trattos and Angeliki Elia, in which participants experienced first-hand a number of activities they could use to engage their students and retain their interest throughout their time at the Greek school.

The communities of Agia Triada and Apostolos Andreas of Birmingham very generously hosted all the conference participants by offering lunch as well as coffee and tea and various treats during the breaks.

Association of Rizokarpasso in Britain holds Annual General Meeting



The 43rd Annual General Meeting of the Association of Rizokarpasso held in the hall of the Cypriot Community Centre, Wood Green, was well attended, and gave the opportunity for the members present to discuss the many challenges faced by Cyprus and the specific issues regarding Rizokarpasso, especially in relation to the plight of compatriots who have been enclaved for over 43 years and denied basic human rights.

Maria Karaolis, the President, presented a report of the Association's activities since the last General Meeting. Andreas Gavrielides, presented the Treasurer's Report. Pavlos Pavlou presented the Auditors Report. The meeting finished with all the members enjoying souvlakia, catching up on news and discussing their arrangements for the Association's summer trip to Brighton on Sunday 24th June and to the Annual Dinner & Dance of the Association on Saturday 24th November.

The AGM was attended by the President of the National Federation of Cypriots in the UK, Christos Karaolis.

The members passed a Resolution to be modified as appropriate and sent to the UK Prime Minister, President of the USA, President of the European Commission, President of the European Council, President of the European Parliament, UN Secretary General, NATO Secretary General, Secretary General of the Commonwealth of Nations and the President of the Republic of Cyprus.

The letter calls upon UK Prime Minister, The Rt Hon Theresa May to not waver from the principles that UK Governments have set out regarding human rights and the upholding of international law.

"We urge you to ensure that your administration remains committed to the UK's obligations as set out in International Law and the Treaty of Guarantee. The UK's continued, constructive contribution is key to progress, not least in the form of pressure upon Turkey to bring about a more positive and constructive engagement. We trust that you took the opportunity during President Erdogan's visit to stand firm on the UK's commitment to the principles which should guide you and your government's actions in

relation to Cyprus; human rights, democratic principles and the rule of law: values which, by its actions, Turkey does not uphold. Furthermore, in violation of the Fourth Geneva Convention, which forbids an occupying power to transfer parts of its own population into the territory it occupies, over 200,000 Turkish nationals were transferred from Turkey to settle in northern Cyprus and take over the homes and properties of Greek Cypriots.

"The continued occupation of Cyprus by over 40,000 Turkish troops and over 200,000 settlers from Turkey violates human rights, fundamental freedoms and social justice and the very principles at the heart of democracy. Turkey is in flagrant violation of International Law and of the relevant United Nations Security Council Resolutions including General Assembly Resolution 3212 (1974). We believe that Turkey's role as a NATO member should be reviewed and its progress towards EU membership should be frozen until it complies with international law and UN Resolutions.

Turkey mistreats its minorities, violates freedom of speech, restricts the media and press; it is not a democracy and should not be allowed to exploit the current migration crisis in Europe. We believe that Turkey should comply with International Law and abide by the values upheld by the UN, NATO, and the Council of Europe of which Turkey is a Members State. Therefore, a negotiated solution for Cyprus should encompass:

- a) The reunification of the island and people of Cyprus.
- b) The removal of all Turkish troops from Cyprus.
- c) The repatriation to Turkey of over 200,000 illegal settlers in Cyprus.
- d) The return of all properties to their lawful owners.
- e) The return of all the refugees to their homes and properties in safety.
- f) The abolition of the anachronistic Guarantor Status held by other countries.
- g) The full and effective investigation of the fate of all the missing persons.

Insuring your rental property correctly

There have been a number of stories in recent months about how landlords have suffered costly damage to their rental properties and have not been covered by their insurance policies. Such stories highlight the importance of carefully scrutinising what is and isn't covered in your landlord's insurance policy.

Following an argument, an angry tenant left his property owner with £17,000 worth of damage. The destruction included abusive graffiti, animal faeces and vandalised fixtures and fittings, which the Blackpool landlord believed may have been caused by intentionally breeding dogs in a 'makeshift cot'. The landlord was not fully covered, as his policy excluded damage caused by tenants and animals.


There are several common exclusions that come with landlord policies. Accidental damage is not always excluded, but cover is inconsistent from one insurer to the next.

Some policies include damage caused by children, for example, whilst others do not.

Many accidental damage clauses can be extended to offer additional cover. Remember, though, that your tenants should insure their own belongings – you are only obliged to ensure the structure of the building and any belongings you provide as part of the tenancy.

Animals: Chewing, fouling, scratching and tearing damage caused by animals are, as the unfortunate property owner from Blackpool found out, often not covered.

Sometimes damage caused by attempts at amateur repairs



will not be covered. This might also include damage caused by cleaning. Insurers often will not cover damage unless the job was completed professionally, but a professional trader should also have professional indemnity and public liability insurance.

Malicious damage by your tenant (or by anyone when the property is vacant) is frequently excluded.

Where an insured peril might be covered but this can be argued to be as a result of malicious damage, an insurer may reject the claim. For instance, water damage may be covered, but if the damage was the result of the tenant deliberately vandalising the water pipes it may not be.

Samsara's Top Tips on Fitness, Nutrition, Beauty and Lifestyle

Dare to bare

The glorious sun is out and so are we with those feet now out of the boots and shoes. The feet need cooling and airing with sandals and flip flops at the ready, but are those feet ready I wonder? Sometimes a little neglected and less pampered in the winter, but now you can no longer keep them hidden and it's time to step up the regime and get to work on them as they are always working for you.

As a dancer and fitness person, my feet really do work hard. The constant tip toe dancing barefoot at home or work along with other sports and all the pivoting around tends to take its toll. I have to pedicure regularly and even once a week wouldn't be enough to keep them silky smooth.

Our feet were designed to help us walk and work on hard rough grounds barefoot. We were not born with those shoes that we love to wear. Our feet work us on rough ground surfaces and sands. Originally, the soles of feet hardened with skin underneath in order for us not to feel the grit and grainy paths on walking. As man designed shoes for comfort and ease, the need of keeping feet rough underneath was no longer a necessity and attractive feet became the desire for many



with toe and foot jewellery to temporary or permanent tattooing becoming fashionably normal.

So what can you do to keep those hard working feet at their best? The amount of times per month will vary greatly upon how you use those feet. If your work is sedentary and your hobbies are similar or sport activity is limited, your feet may need a pedicure once a month comfortably, compared to another whose work is actively standing or walking all day. Add along some physical foot power loaded activity or wearing high heels frequently and it is more likely that a pedicure will be needed weekly or fortnightly to keep them at their best. This can be done at your local beauty or spa studio or you can do it

yourself in the comfort of your own home.

Start by always soaking your feet first in a bowl of comfortably hot water, to this you can add a little of your favourite foot wash or bath soak. In salons surprisingly, some Dettol or Listerine mouth wash is often added for the antiseptic qualities and its cooling refreshing aid. Let your feet soak till the hard skin areas such as the heels, front of the foot and toes, become soft. This should take around 10 minutes or so.

Next, only if you have extremely hard skin, use a pedi blade very carefully on those areas only. Be careful not to catch the soft areas as they may be cut quite easily if you are not used to using this. If you are not using a pedi

blade, you can skip straight to using the rasp. The rasp resembles that of a grater. Pedi egg and other such products are great for this. It will also take off any surplus hard skin. Rasp work best in following and working in line with the skin grain line direction. Always leave a little tiny amount of hard skin on the prominent areas and don't be over zealous with tools used as you may find that you will feel even a pin under your feet that will be very uncomfortable.

Find the balance that works for you and your lifestyle activity. Finally go over with a foot file on the areas you have just worked on to smooth out rough edges. Wash off all that dead skin with a hard skin removing and exfoliating cream. You can then add a good moisturising cream of your choice.

If you are cutting toenails, remember to cut straight across to avoid in-growing toenails. Sharp corners can be filed round a little just to avoid in-growing or catching. Remember to keep nails shorter than end of toes for safety to avoid injury. Apply a ridge filling basecoat and then your coats of nail polish and a top coat to seal and last longer.

Deadpool 2

Ryan Reynolds returns as Marvel's foul mouthing superhero Wade Wilson AKA Deadpool in this enjoyable action packed sequel - this time directed by David Leitch, an actor, stunt man, producer, who made his directorial debut in JOHN WICK before ATOMIC BLONDE.

Wade is very much in love with Vanessa (Morena Baccarin) with whom he wants to settle down and have children but circumstances force him back to the world of superheroes and mutants when the life of Russell (Julian Dennison), a boy with supernatural abilities is threatened by the powerful time traveller Cable (Josh Brolin). Wade joins forces with a team of mutants including Bedlam, Shatterstar and Domino in order to protect the boy...

Reynolds is having so much fun in sending up his image as well as many movies including FLASHDANCE and GREEN LANTERN that his enjoyment is highly infectious.

The careful casting includes Josh Brolin fresh from his monumental villain Thanos in AVENGERS, who makes a fine double act with Reynolds. But the real revelation here is Julian Dennison the untameable boy from the New Zealand international hit HUNT OF THE WILDERPEOPLE as the boy with a strong attitude ready to use his supernatural powers to avenge those that abused him.

One of the most enjoyable of the recent superhero movies that doesn't take itself too seriously!

On Chesil Beach



the film is the Dorset hotel and the fateful wedding night. Ronan is a striking presence and so is Howle but curiously their tender love story fails to touch the heart. The fragmented nature of the script which continuously changes time and place is probably another factor that prevents us from getting too close to the characters and identifying with them.

Dominic Cooke's adaptation of Shakespeare's THE HOLLOW CROWN for television was celebrated for its imagination and flair which makes his first cinematic effort even more disappointing despite good intentions and a strong cast.

Another film from last year's London Film Festival is this brilliant documentary about an actor whose work has become synonymous with that of Stanley Kubrick's.

Probably not many people have heard of Leon Vitali, an upcoming actor in the early seventies with solid television experience, who landed a juicy part in Kubrick's BARRY LYNDON in 1975.

This was a life changing experience for Vitali, who decided to turn down any future work so he can work exclusively for Kubrick. He was the acting coach to the child actor in THE SHINING, the casting director for FULL METAL JACKET and EYERS WIDE SHUT but most importantly he became Kubrick's right hand man for almost everything.

It is an excellent film with some rare archive material plus interviews with Ryan O'Neil and Matthew Modine amongst others.

McEwan's screenplay plays with time with many flashback sequences but the centre of

Gabrielle Union carries this taut thriller valiantly as the resourceful mother under James McTeigue's imaginative direction.

When her father dies in a hit and run accident Shaun Russell takes her son and daughter to his holiday home in the countryside. She wants to put the high-tech home on the market but as soon as they arrive at this remote destination four men break into the house searching for hidden money...

The plot is simple - the men break in while the feisty heroine having escaped from their clutches wants to break back in and save her captive children. Union excels as the quick-witted heroine determined to outsmart the brutal thugs and save her family. McTeigue, the director of V FOR VENDETTA, uses the sole location to a great effect with a feisty female protagonist right in the middle of the action.

A Cambodian Spring

Chris Kelly's powerful documentary follows three Cambodian activists as they struggle with the fascistic authorities in order to save their land from demolition.

This epic film was shot over the period of 6 years and the two women along with the

Buddhist monk and their small community never give up in protesting for better land rights.



Kelly's compelling film is a remarkable achievement - it is harrowing but also inspiring to see this small group of people prepared to put their lives on the line in order to achieve their goal and offer the younger generation a better future.

The Sound Of Music (in 70mm)



Re-living the magic of Robert Wise's impeccably directed film, which looks absolutely stunning in 70mm, is an utterly joyous experience! It is one of the best loved family films of all time which has become a global phenomenon since its original release in 1965.

Julie Andrews is Maria, the novice nun sent by her Mother Superior to work as a governess for Captain Georg Von Trapp's (Christopher Plummer) seven children.

The film inspired by true events boasts stunning songs and magnificent locations that will stay with you forever.

Debauched before change

Bohemians rejoice. Hedonists hail the day, I have found the perfect play for you. Three hours of uninhibited indulgence. You will lose yourself in scenes of unadulterated madness and pleasure. Ok there is a serious undertone. *Absolute Hell* (**National Theatre**) is anything but, more like an inferno of promiscuity. Rodney Ackland's 1952 play, originally called *The Pink Room*, is set during the last days of World War II in a Soho den of iniquity where almost anything goes as long as it is accompanied by copious amounts of alcohol. Sixty-five years ago, they weren't ready for the play and it met with a 'Mary Whitehouse' (Google) response. Today it's possibly dated and uncontroversial but still very enjoyable.

As most Londoners endure the Blitz on rations, their future unknown, others decide to ignore the possibility of Nazi masters and lose themselves in the delights of *La Vie En Rose*, run by randy Christine, determined to screw every American GI that crosses her threshold. She happily welcomes all those meandering through life in their own inimitable way and my what a gaggle of queer folk they are. They include arrogant film producer Maurice, Elizabeth who wants always to be high as a kite and Hugh a permanent fixture and permanently drunk. Just the kind of place feted Soho socialite Jeffrey Bernard would have loved. A haven of louche misdemeanours though the one gay relationship, carried out in the shadows, is depicted sensitively and lovingly, a chink of light in difficult times.

Director Joe Hill-Gibbin adopts a colourful and adventurous approach, leading us through the nooks and crannies of the sordid labyrinth, asking us not to be judgemental but understanding of a group of folk grappling with harsh realities in their own escapist way. The cast rise to the challenge of keeping us interested and salaciously involved with performances of great energy and craft. Kate Fleetwood is superb as Christine her libido hiding a mass of insecurities and Charles Edwards similarly impresses as Hugh, a one-time writer of repute and now a drunk and scrounger of repute. Rachel Dale is prostitute Fifi who comes and goes making it clear that this is her domain whatever the drunk intellectuals may think.

Lizzie Clachan's set fills the stage, lots of places to hide in the dim light provided by pink lampshades, reminiscent of a Parisian boudoir. Being hidden is central to their existence and lifestyle while outside much is about to change. Witty, entertaining and poignant, a brew to savour.

Meanwhile *Jonoulla Havana* loves the play but... Barney Norris's *Nightfall* (**Bridge Theatre**) is set on a farm in Hampshire. Things are not going well for the family and over the course of the play, four different evenings, we see them struggling with the dreams and realities. It is a masterful portrayal of an adult family bound together emotionally and financially, with all their burning resentments and desires exposed. The unwritten manual which the children operate under is beautifully depicted, leaving you wincing at the suffocating prison they occupy. However, mum and son are umbilically attached to duty and blood ties which leads to inevitable tensions and conflict.

The guilt at wanting to escape, the desire to do something differently with the farm to survive, and the role of the stranger in their midst; the dead father and the boyfriend recently released from prison are all very powerfully presented and explored. These are communities about whom we hear or see very little on stage and Norris writes as though it is part exposé and part eulogy. Rae Smith's design is wonderfully creative, textured and evocative, and the various props and furniture very realistic. The strong cast perform well as an ensemble, particularly so in the better second half, which ramps up the emotion. A play worth getting to grips with.

On the down side, if this is supposed to be a new theatre for the people of London then it needs to be more accessible and appeal to a variety of tastes and wallets, rather than sell ridiculously expensive food and treats.

And Timotheus Christou gets into a lovely lather... I had no idea what to expect which is no bad thing, I love being surprised. *Soap* (**Udderbelly Festival - Spiegeltent**) is a show that features bathtubs and performers in their pristine white (thankfully) "undies" doing all sorts of extraordinary things. It has been put together by German company, Base Berlin, and I'm sure I noticed at least one routine that was suggestive of a middle finger to Brexit or maybe I had too much soap in my eyes. I would sum it up like this; a complete surprise, very unpretentious - they do not take themselves seriously, funny and dramatic in equal measure, mesmerising and hypnotic, brilliantly choreographed and sexy but never inappropriate. This is very much a case of bend me, shape me, any way you want me...all in a bathtub! There is also a wonderfully charming clown making this the ideal show for summer fun and frolicking.

Finally, Anoushka Gregoriou's eyes enjoy but ears hurt... First came The Rat Pack and now we have *The Tap Pack* (**Peacock Theatre**). Clever name, cracking show. Five blokes from Australia who can sing, dance, juggle and smile loads, all to the music of Sinatra and Co. Tap dancing can become monotonous but the way these fellas mix things up there is little chance of that. They look good, they dress well and are accompanied by an on-stage band who help create a popping atmosphere. There's no doubt Sean Mulligan is leader of the pack, both in age and stature though the other guys have plenty to offer. Jesse Rasmussen brings Fred Astaire to life and Thomas J Egan conjures up an improvised routine that is spectacular. They should perhaps market themselves as the "Aussie tap attack", especially so when they all dance together.

Beware though the macho banter that happens throughout in between numbers. Its lazy Bondi Beach crap chat that belongs there and not on a London stage.

Following a fiery performance in the Eurovision final on Saturday, Eleni Foureira secured second place for Cyprus – the highest ever position for our island.

Though Israel was crowned winner of the 63rd Eurovision Song Contest, with an absolutely ridiculous song might I add, the real winner for us was Eleni with her highly catchy entry, *Fuego*.

The singer had all the major news networks speaking about her explosive performance; this and Eleni being the bookies' favourite to win, helped Cyprus come closer than ever to its first Eurovision victory, since its debut in 1981.

Despite not winning the contest, Eleni certainly made Cypriots proud, giving us our best ever Eurovision result, with a total of 436 points.

26 countries took part in the Grand Final of the world's longest running annual television music competition, which this year was hosted at the Altice Arena in Lisbon, Portugal.

Israel's winning song, *Toy*, performed by Netta, finished


with 529 points. Austria's Cesar Sampson with *Nobody But You* finished in third place.

Charilaos Kitromilides

Charilaos Kitromilides was born in Nicosia on the 27th August 1916. Charilaos was a school teacher who became a social worker, when the social welfare service was set up in Cyprus in the early 1950's.

In August 1962 Charilaos Kitromilides arrived in London with his family to take up his post as Welfare Attaché at the recently established Cyprus High Commission. The then minister of labour and social services of Cyprus, Tassos Papadopoulos, decided that Charilaos was the best person to head the welfare section of the Cyprus embassy in London,

a city with a relatively large Cypriot community.

On his retirement from the High commission in 1970 he continued to serve the Cypriot community in London as a social worker for the London borough of Haringay. During that period, he was also active in many community initiatives and voluntary organisations including the Academy Social club of which he was its president for 25 years.

After retiring from Haringay, Charilaos reverted back to his original profession of a teacher. He taught the Greek language to many young persons of the community.



At the same time, he was writing articles on a variety of subjects

published in the community press and contributed to the programmes of the community radio LGR.

His life-long dedication to community service was recognised by the Civic Authorities when, at the age of 90, he was awarded the Civic Award by the Mayor of Barnet for his contribution to the Greek Cypriot community of Barnet. He continued to be active both physically (walking every day for one hour) and intellectually, well into his old age. At the age of 100 he co-authored with Mr. Costas Kavadas the history of the Greek community of Hendon and

Barnet of which he was a founding member more than 50 years ago.

Charilaos Kitromilides was a much-loved member of the Greek Cypriot community in London. He was a teacher, a writer, a broadcaster and a devoted family man. A regular church-goer and a deeply religious person, he will be greatly missed by all, no less by his family - his daughter, his daughter in law, his son and his three grandsons. His funeral will be held at the Greek Orthodox Church of the Holy Cross and Archangel Michael, in Golders Green, on Friday, the 25th of May 12 noon.


